This shelter has a 33 bed women's shelter, an 85 bed men's shelter as well as a family unit. They are a 24-Hour Emergency Shelter and they provide a Literacy/Computer Training Program, Substance Abuse Counseling, HIV/AIDS program, Food, Clothing, Housing Assistance, Job Search assistance and Counseling, Life Skills Counseling, and Health Care advice. 1-(510)-532-3211
